## 5. Eventual Extremely Low Bid Price Issues

The Negotiated Procedure has been cancelled, therefore the Exrememly Low Bid Price issue is irrelevant

## 6. Grounds for the Use of Negotiated Procedure Without Publication

The Negotiated Procedure has been organised in accordance with Sec 23 (5) a of the ACT.

The reasons for the use of this provision were that the subject matter of the Negotiated Procedure is delivery of a technology which does not yet exist in the world, represents above the state of the art technology and has yet to be developed by the supplier.

The Technology is a unique system to be delivered according to detailed technical specifications set forth as part of the Tender Documentation and shall by no means be produced in an assembly-line (batch) manner.

On the part of the supplier the Technology is developed and delivered as research and development project for a third party. On the part of the Contracting Authority, the Technology shall be delivered for the purposes of the ELI-Beamlines Project awarded to the Contracting Authority as part of the Research and Development for Innovations Operational Programme 2007-2013. The Technology shall not be developed and delivered with the aim of achieving profit (on either party's side<sup>2</sup>), nor with the aim to cover the costs of the Contracting Authority.

Finally, at the moment of opening of the Negotiated Procedure, the Contracting Authority was not in place to stipulate all legal, economical or technical aspects of the tender. Therefore, it was necessary to negotiate these with potential applicants. The state of the Contracting Authority's knowledge of the technical aspects of the tender in the latest phases of the Negotiated Procedure has led to the necessity to enable variant bids pursuant to Sec 70 of the Act.

The use of the Negotiated Procedure has been validated by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports.

### 7. Grounds for cancellation of the Negotiated Procedure

During the Negotiated Procedure only one bid has been submitted within the stipulated deadline (hereinafter the "*Bid*").

During the Assessment of the Bid, the following discrepancies have been identified by the Bid Assessment and Evaluation Committee (hereinafter the "Committee"):

- on page 5 of the Bid the Bidder stated by way of footnote reference that the "Prices represent best available figures at the time of submission of the contract. Because of future uncertainties Additional Spares are only estimates. They are subject to change subsequent to completion of the of the Engineering Design (Milestone D2). Consequently, line items 1 and 6 are subject to change when Option is exercised. The Contractor will supply a binding quote upon request after Milestone D2 which will be valid fo 60 days from the request. (Because of large uncertainty in kJ beam transport mirrors, this price reflects a "no bid" on this at this time.)"
- on page 6 and 333 of the Bid with respect to the Bid Price for the Spare Parts Call-In Option, at the position 14 Full set of output kJ beam transport mirrors with 2 OAPs the Bidder (instead of providing a bid unit price) stated "No bid (to be determined with design)".

The Committee assessed the above discrepancies as clearly making the Bid incomplete and non-compliant with the Tender Documentation. The nature of these discrepancies (the Bidder clearly stated it's will not to make a bid for the position Nr. 14 and that the Total Bid Price is not a final bid price, but a sole estimate) did not enable the Contracting Authority to resolve these discrepancies by way of Bid Explanation.

Therefore, the Committee recommended the Contracting Authority to exclude the Bid from the Negotiated Procedure and to cancel the Negotiate Procedure pursuant to Sec. 84 (1) b) of the Act.

Following the Committee's recommendation, the Contracting Authority has removed the the Bid of the bidder consortium of National Energetics, Inc., 2320 Donley Drive, #C, Austin, Texas, 78758 USA and Ekspla, Savanoriu Av. 231, LT-02300m Vilnius from the Negotiated Procedure and has cancelled the Negotiated Procedure.
