

**OUTCOME OF THE ASSESSMENT OF FULFILMENT OF THE CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROCUREMENT PROCEDURE IN RESPECT OF THE SELECTED ECONOMIC OPERATOR**

Assessment of fulfilment of the conditions of participation in the procurement procedure:

- Assessment of the fulfilment of the technical conditions defining the subject of the Public Contract - Based on the data provided by the bidder in his bid, specifically in Annexes No. 1 and 2 of the Draft Contract, the bidder has met the minimum requirements set by the Contracting Authority for the subject of the Public Contract.
- Assessment of compliance with **technical qualification** requirements - the bidder submitted the required list of significant supplies provided over the past three years before the commencement of the procurement procedure ("AMT Example customers for Post-Processing plastic 3D printed parts"). Supply of any equipment matching the principle of



function with the equipment whose supply is the subject of this Part of the Public Contract, with financial value of at least 500.000,- CZK excl. VAT, was considered a significant supply. The Contracting Authority requested at least 2 such supplies.

The list contained the required data and the individual reference supplies met the required parameters.

The following data on individual reference supplies from the list of significant supplies submitted by the bidder are decisive to demonstrate compliance with the technical qualification requirements:

- c) Assessment of fulfilment of commercial or other contractual conditions related to the subject of the Public Contract - The bidder fulfilled the commercial terms and conditions set by the Contracting Authority, in particular by submitting a signed binding draft of the Contract (in the exact wording as it formed Annex 2a of the Tender Documentation).
- d) Assessment of fulfilment of conditions set by the Contracting Authority for fulfilment of Section 6 (4) of the Act (compliance with the principles of socially and environmentally responsible procurement) – The bidder submitted an Affidavit with a commitment guaranteeing compliance with the principles pursuant to Section 6 (4) of the Act.
- e) Assessment of the fulfilment of the requirements of the Contracting Authority on the content, form or manner of submitting bids - The bidder fulfilled the requirements set by the Contracting Authority on the content, form and manner of submitting bids, i.e. the bid was submitted electronically through an electronic tool, it was submitted in English, it included the bidder's identification data, the data for evaluation and the bid price was processed in accordance with the requirements of the Contracting Authority. The bid was submitted in the structure requested by the Contracting Authority and contained a Draft Contract with filled-in marked data.



- f) Assessment of the bid price in the sense of whether it is an abnormally low bid price within the meaning of Section 113 of the Act - The Contracting Authority did not find the bid price to be abnormally low in relation to the subject of the Public Contract. At the same time, the bid price did not exceed the maximum admissible bid price, which amounted to 1.936.000,00 CZK including 21% VAT.
